The Swauk Teanaway Grange will award one or more \$1,000 in scholarship money in 2017. To be eligible, you must be a high school senior or enrolled in a home school program in Kittitas County and graduating in 2017.

Qualifications for applying for this scholarship are the following:

- An agricultural background or history of participation in agricultural activities or plans to pursue
  a career in an agriculture-related field. Examples are 4-H and Future Farmers of America (FFA).
   Include offices held and awards received.
- Community and school involvement, including leadership experience and awards received.
- Grade point average--to be verified with transcript. If you are in Running Start, Cornerstone, or
   College in the Classroom, be sure to include your CWU transcript.

Preference will be given to applicants with Grange membership or whose family members have a history of Grange membership. If possible, please provide documentation with your application. Membership applications are available from Sally Gililand, chair of the Scholarship Committee.

Complete all sections of this application. Forms must be received by our committee <u>no later than</u> March 17, 2017. These include your application form, letter of application, and transcript(s). Incomplete applications will not be considered. Do not submit a resume or letters of recommendation. Finalists may be interviewed before a final selection of the winner is made.
