- Cover letter in proper business form (sample attached) describing your qualifications. Include your future plans and goals and your need for our scholarship. Limit: 2 pages. Be sure to sign.
- Application- Complete and legible (typed or in blue or black pen). You may attach one page if you need additional room for this information. Use a similar font.
- Official sealed high school transcript of all complete courses. Must be dated close to application date.

Complete all sections of this application. Forms must be postmarked <u>no later than</u> March 1, 2024. These include your application form, letter, and transcript. Incomplete applications will not be considered. Finalists may be interviewed before a final selection of the winner is made. Please do not submit a resume in lieu of filling in all sections of the application form.
