- Official sealed high school transcript of all completed courses. Must be dated close to application date.
- Official sealed college transcript of all completed courses if you are in Running Start.

We suggest keeping copies of your application materials for future reference. Do not submit this page.

Complete all sections of this application. Forms must be postmarked <u>no later than</u> March 1, 2025. These include your application form, letter, and transcripts. Finalists may be interviewed before a final selection of the winner is made.
